Indiana Angus E-Mail Newsletters

These emails are designed and created for the sole purpose of sharing information that relates to all members. If you as a member would like to specifically use that list for your own marketing purposes, such as a sale catalog or to request RSVPs for your own event, you are entitled to 1 dedicated email annually.

These emails will be sent out at the discretion of our marketing team and as our content schedule dictates. If you require a specific scheduled time or specific design and proofs prior to sending, a fee of \$25 per email will be assessed, payable to the Indiana Angus Association.

EMAIL NEWSLETTER GUIDELINES

Indiana Angus Association offers a twice monthly email newsletter (eblast) to help membership, regional leadership, and even potential members understand everything that is going on in current events and upcoming activities. This email newsletter is used in special circumstances to promote farm sales, upcoming events, and other opportunities as a part of membership dues, but can also be purchased for additional promotion.

If you would like to put information in our Association eblast that is sent to all membership, please make sure to follow these guidelines:

- Two informational eblasts will be sent out monthly: one on or near the 5th of each month and one on or near the 20th of each month.
- Additional eblasts will be sent out to feature advertisers, promote digital editions, etc.
- Any additions to the eblast should be sent to Krista Stillwell at krista.stillwell@gmail.com.
- Copy / artwork needed to be used should be sent no later than 24 hours prior to each scheduled send for inclusion (no later than the 4th or the 19th).
- Any items received in between will be saved for the next scheduled eblast, but may be shared in other forms such as the blog on the website or on Facebook for additional promotion and reinforcement.

In the future, development of a "potential members" list is in the works for promotional opportunities outside of IAA Membership.
